On January 29, 2010, the **Alaska Pipeline Project** launched the first natural gas open season process in the history of the North Slope, a major milestone in developing Alaska's natural gas resources. The open season will allow North Slope producers and other possible shippers to evaluate the project's plans and reserve space on the pipeline to ship natural gas to Alaska, North America and, potentially, international markets.

Under the Alaska Gasline Inducement Act (AGIA), an unprecedented framework for success has been built. Three major players have joined together to develop North Slope natural gas — **TransCanada**, **ExxonMobil** and the **State of Alaska**.

The **Alaska Pipeline Project** would generate billions of dollars in tax revenues and royalties for Alaska, create jobs and economic activity, and meet Alaska's long-term natural gas needs by providing opportunities for in-state access to gas to heat homes, fuel businesses and generate electricity.
